

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

### YEAR 9, YEAR 10 and YEAR 11 GIRLS

#### Skirt or Kilt (Either can be worn all year)

Skirt—Available for purchase from South Otago High School

Kilt—Please contact South Otago High School Office for kilt 'order' information

#### White Shirt

Plain college style, long or short sleeve, reverse collar. Two styles available

#### Socks/Tights

White, mid-calf length socks or black/navy tights

### YEAR 12 and YEAR 13 GIRLS

#### Skirt or Kilt (Either can be worn all year)

As for Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11 girls

#### White Shirt

Plain college style, long or short sleeve, reverse collar. Two styles available

#### School Tie

Blue and red stripe. Optional. Must only be worn correctly with a white stiff-collared shirt

#### School Blazer

Royal blue blazer may be worn by senior students

#### Socks/Tights

White, mid-calf length socks or black/navy tights

### YEAR 9, YEAR 10 and Year 11 BOYS

#### Shirt

Aertex blue shirt. These are purchased through South Otago High School

#### Shorts or Trousers

Regulation grey shorts or long grey trousers

#### Socks

Grey with red, white and blue trim

### YEAR 12 and YEAR 13 BOYS

#### Shirt

White, long sleeved college shirt to be worn with tie. Optional white, untucked style, short sleeved shirt without tie.

#### School Tie

Blue and red stripe School tie only

#### School Blazer

Royal blue blazer may be worn by senior students

#### Shorts or Trousers

Regulation grey shorts or long grey trousers

#### Socks

Grey with red, white and blue trim

## ALL STUDENTS

#### Jersey

Regulation royal blue V-neck jersey with monogram

#### Vest (optional)

A sleeveless, royal blue woolen vest, similar style to jersey

#### Jacket

Black puffer jacket, navy blue polar fleece or plain black jacket (no labels)

#### Scarf

Navy, black or red—single colour. No combinations

#### Gloves

Navy blue or black—single colour. No combinations

#### Footwear

Black, low heeled, college-style shoes (must be able to be polished); plain college style

T-Bar shoe for girls. Brown Roman sandals worn without socks in Terms 1 and 4 (Optional)

#### T-shirts

Plain white t-shirt may be worn under shirt/blouse

#### Beanies

Navy blue or black—single colour (no logos)

#### Caps

Students are encouraged to wear the school cap during the summer months. These are available to purchase at SOHS.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

#### PE Top/Sports Top

Navy Blue and Red Embroidered Quickdry Crew Neck tee or Singlet

Sports Hoodie—Optional

#### PE Shorts, Trackpants, Gym Pants

Navy Blue shorts or trackpants—No Logo, or 3/4 length Gym Pants

## PERSONAL GROOMING

**Hair— Year 9, 10, 11 students** Students must tie hair back once it reaches the collar.

Hair tie must be a plain, single colour (not combinations). Hair clips or combs are to be the colour of the hair. Students are not permitted to wear their hair in such a way that it could bring disrespect to the school. Extreme hair styles and unnatural colours are not acceptable.

**Boys**—Boys must be clean shaven.

**Jewellery:** Limited to functional jewellery; wrist watch or medic-alert bracelet. Students have the option of wearing one small silver or gold stud or sleeper (maximum 12mm), in each ear only. Facial piercings are not permitted. Taonga may be worn under clothing. Jewellery should be removed for physical education, sport and Technology.

**Make-up:** Students may not wear noticeable make-up whilst in school uniform
